OUR PROGRAMS

Young Preschool

Ages 3 - 3 ½ **Days** T/TH **Time** 9:00AM - 12:00PM

This class is designed for younger children who may be in a peer group for the first time. Circle time and group activities will be short and designed for early social skills. Class size will be limited to 10-12 children with a minimum of 1 teacher and 1 assistant in the classroom.

Older Preschool

Ages 3 ½ - 5 **Days** M/W/F **Time** 9:00AM - 12:00PM

This class is designed for children ready for more time in class and a bit more structure. The planned activities are longer as well as circle time. Group activities will be designed to take more time and have more advanced skills. Class size will be limited to 16 children with 1 teacher and 1 assistant in the classroom.


Young Preschool
