Fifteenth Lambeth Conference July 26 – August 8, 2022

Convened by The Archbishop of Canterbury in 2022, the Lambeth Conference is a gathering of bishops from across the 165 countries of the Anglican Communion for prayer and reflection, fellowship and dialogue on church and world affairs - to pray, study scripture, discuss global challenges and seek God's direction for the decade ahead.

With the theme of 'God's Church for God's World - walking, listening and witnessing together,' the conference will explore what it means for the Anglican Communion to be responsive to the needs of a 21st Century world. Climate change, war and poverty are on the agenda.

In his foreword to the Conference guide, Archbishop Josiah Idowu-Fearon, Secretary General of the Anglican Communion, wrote: "These words reflect perhaps Christ's greatest challenge to the Church: To be one. To live as a united body, in service to Christ and to one another.

As we gather in 2022, may we commit ourselves to this significant moment as an opportunity to listen to one another, learn from the diversity of our communities and church experiences and seek to serve one another."

Emmanuel's Coffee Hour is so well loved! It is a great time of fellowship and snacking along with a cup of coffee or tea.

We just need some cookies, or muffins, or any quick breads like banana bread. Selecting something from a supermarket works too. Some half and half for the coffee, and you are set to go.

We have a new coffee maker that now has three warming plates, a great help on a busy morning.

1. When you arrive, be sure the coffee maker is plugged in, then run a pot of just water through (catching it with another empty pot).
2. Right before the service ends (after you have taken communion) make two pots of regular then one pot of the Decaf.
3. The hot pot for tea sits on the other end of the counter. Plug this in then press the tab to start the heating process. When the light goes off, the hot water is ready to go.

Instructions for these steps and where to find the coffee packets is taped to the serving counter next to the coffee maker.

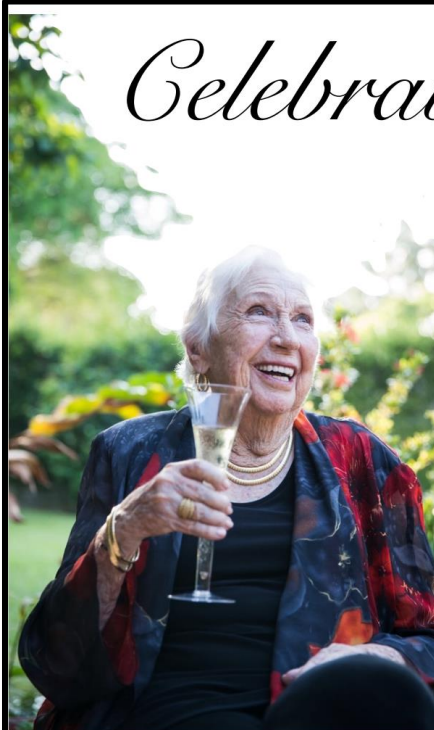
The sign-up sheet is on the end of the serving counter. We so appreciate your gift of hosting for this much loved part of our Sunday Morning.

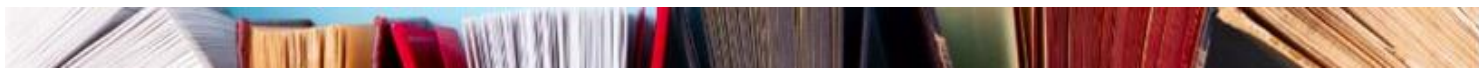


ABC@ Emmanuel
